

Calisthenics Victoria Competition Etiquette

1. Act respectfully towards others including team members, other clubs, volunteers and officials.
2. Be mindful that language or behaviour that you perceive as acceptable, may still be offensive to others.
3. Wear tracksuit pants and socks/shoes in theatre and foyer as legs and feet should be covered.
4. Do not wear costumes in the theatre.
5. Walls must not be used for handstands or stretching.
6. Obey theatre rules on where you can eat or drink.
7. Do not talk or move around the theatre while teams are performing.
8. Give recognition to all performers whether first, second or third teams
9. Competitors must not sit in the first two rows of the theatre.
10. Do not verbally criticise your fellow competitors or the Adjudicator.
11. Be quiet around the stage area, you can be heard from most dressing rooms.
12. Keep all your belongings together as there are others using the dressing room. Personal items and valuables should be left with a representative of your club. (CVI and its ancillary organisations/committees and theatres will not be responsible for any losses)
13. Be courteous and stay in the theatre for all speeches and aggregate presentations.
14. Leave dressing rooms clean and tidy at the completion of competitions.
15. Flashlights, videos, cameras, mobile phones, iPads, laptops, tablets and pagers are not to be operated in the theatre or dressing rooms.
16. Observe all Smoke Free designated areas.
17. No alcoholic beverages are to be consumed in dressing rooms, nor brought to the competition venue for consumption, if the premises are licenced.
